

Application for Vote-By-Mail Ballot Information

Vote-By-Mail ballot request information is confidential and exempt under section 101.62(3), F.S., with one exception. The following specified persons or entities are statutorily authorized to obtain this information for political purposes only: 1) the canvassing board, 2) an election official, 3) a political party or official thereof, 4) a registered political committee, 5) a committee of continuous existence, 6) a candidate who has filed qualification papers and is opposed in an upcoming election, and 7) Voter (entitled only to access his or her own Vote-By-Mail ballot request information directly from Supervisor of Elections for county of residence.

The Bradford County Supervisor of Elections posts on its website daily reports of Vote-By-Mail ballot request information. To access this information, please check the applicable authorization and complete this form:

- An election official** **A candidate who has filed qualification papers and is opposed in an upcoming election**
- A political party or official thereof** **Political committee**
- Committee of continuous existence**
